We've been doing some work across the school this week to celebrate the Year of St Joseph. Lots of exciting things have been going on that you can ask your children about, including making lilies for our class prayer tables, making fishes from salt dough and sharing some great research that the children did for their homework.



Bikes and scooters

Initially, when the Covid restrictions were put in place we had to ask children not to bring their bikes and scooters to school because it would mean children from different bubbles would mix in the storage area. Many of you have been asking me when we will be allowed to start cycling to school again and so we've been thinking about how we can do this while still adhering to the Covid guidelines.

What I'd like to propose is that from Monday, each class will be allocated an area in the school grounds where they can leave their bikes. Unfortunately we wouldn't be able to store the bikes or scooters under cover or lock them up, but if you are happy with that, then I'd be happy to allow children to bring them in again. I went around the school this afternoon talking to the children so they know where their allocated storage area is.
