Music	Hey You!	When listening to music at home think about: Pulse — the regular heartbeat of the music; its steady beat. Rhythm — long and short sounds or patterns that happen over the pulse. Pitch — high and low sounds. Tempo — the speed of the music; fast or slow or in-between.

Computing	Understanding what is technology	When supervised please allow your children to show you their typing and editing skills on word. Continue to discuss staying safe on the internet.
