Reading	RWI Phonics and Reading Masters Esio Trot The Magic Finger	Daily reading at home Checking the reading makes sense, explaining what has happened in the text, answering ques- tions on the text especially 'why do you think?' Reminding children to take the quiz in school when they are confident with their understanding of the text.
Writing	Texts-Esio Trot The Magic Finger The Bee that Spoke	Practise recognising punctuation e.g full stops, capital letters, question marks and exclamation marks. Practise handwriting at home with correct orientation and size.
Maths	Position and Directions, Problem solving and efficient methods, Time, weight volume and temperature	Ensure completion of homework set on My Maths and prac- tise times tables on the Times tables Rockstars program
Science	Habitats Feeding and Exercise	Read the knowledge organisers on the school website, espe- cially the vocabulary.
R.E	Come and See topics Spread the word, Rules, Treasures, Islam- other faith	Support with learning school prayers (on the website) Reading Bible stories
Geography	Our Wonderful World	Discuss with your child about where the different foods come from. Read the knowledge organisers on the school website, especially the vocabulary.
Art	Sculpture and 3D design	Read the knowledge organisers on the school website, espe- cially the vocabulary.
PSHE	We meet God's love in our Community Relationships Changing Me	Ask your child about their learning.
Music	Friendship song	Ask your child about their learning. When listening to music ask them 'which instruments are playing in the song or piece of music.' Finding the pulse in the music and clapping the rhythms of songs
PE	Led by our Sports Coaches	Children wear P.E. kit to school on Mondays and Thursdays
Computing	Programming quizzes-Scratch Junior	
Design and technology	Mechanisms-Moving Monsters	Read the knowledge organisers on the school website, espe- cially the vocabulary.
