Welcome to Year 3, we are looking forward to an exciting Autumn Term with a visit to Butser Farm and of course all the usual Advent and Christmas activities. As well as an over view of the term we have included ideas of how you can support your children with their learning at home.

Year 4 Spring Term Curriculum		How you can support learning at home
Reading	As a class we are reading and discussing: Autumn 1—The Lost Happy Endings Autumn 2— Life in the Stone Age	Please listen to your child read their reading book daily and ask them questions about what they have read, get them to show you the evidence in the text to support their answer. Challenge them to summarise a paragraph or section of their book.
Writing	We will be writing a variety of pieces to entertain, inform and persuade on. Autumn 1— The Lost Happy Endings Autumn 2— Stone Age Boy	Autumn 1— Our book is based around fairy tales. You can support your child by reading fairy tales at home, looking at the language and characters . Autumn 2— Enjoy reading fiction and non fiction books about the Stone Age.
Maths	Autumn 1—Place Value, addition and subtraction Autumn 2—Multiplication and division	Discuss key vocabulary for the topic with your child. Overviews of the unit for each half term are on Teams. Learn the 3,4 and 8 times table.
Science	Autumn 1—Magnet and Forces Autumn 2—Movement and Feeding	Discuss key vocabulary for the topic with your child. Overviews of the unit for each half term are on Teams. Conduct some experiments at home with Magnets. What can you find in your home that is magnetic? Can you perform your own magnetic magic trick? Read books together about your body and how it moves. Talk about the different types of food we need and what makes a healthy diet.
R.E	Home, Promises, Judaism and Visitors	Discuss the sacraments and the promises that made. Research Judaism together, discussing similarities and differences.
History/ Geography	Autumn 1— The Stone Age Autumn 2—Climate and Weather	Visit the British Museum or Stonehenge. Research the Stone Age online together. Look weather forecast together, discuss how it changes over a year. Visit a forest or woodland to find out more about the temperate biome. Research different climates and find out about the flora and fauna you would find there.
DT/ Art	Autumn 1—Growing artists, seasonal food Autumn 2—Prehistoric painting	Visit an art gallery, discuss the shapes you can see in pictures and how the artist uses tone. Look at pictures of cave paintings, discuss the colours and subjects chosen by the artists. Find out the countries the food you buy has come from, cook something seasonal together.
PSHE	Being Me Celebrating differences	Discuss being unique. Talk about differences and similarities and how to respect these.
Music	All our work will be based around one song Let us Fly.	Discuss key vocabulary in the knowledge organiser (available on the website)
Computing	Animation, we will be finding out how animations are made and creating our own animation on the iPad.	Watch different animations and discuss how they were created.
Latin	Family and food in Roman Britain	Find out about Roman Britain and what life was like.
