Year 6 Spring Term Curriculum

How you can support learning at home

Reading	Journey to the River Sea, Eva Ibbotson and practice SATS reading paper questions.	Make sure your child is reading a variety of fiction and non-fiction books and changing their books regularly in the school library.
Writing	Children will be completing different tasks such as writing newspapers, poems, diary entries etc.	Focus on practicing handwriting and spelling, punctuation and grammar. Make sure you complete SPAG.com homework.
maths	Decimals, percentages, algebra, measure, ratio and proportion.	Complete MyMaths homework as well as practicing timetables for example on TTRS.
Science	Classifying living things and changing circuits.	Spot different types of living things on your walks and try to classify them using the classification system.
R.E	Galilee to Jerusalem	Encourage your child to pray and attend masses.
Geography & History	Protecting the environment The Ancient Greeks	Get a book from the library about the Ancient Greeks to look at together. Think about ways you can work together in your home to protect the environment.
Art & D&T	Making my voice heard—drawing Playgrounds— structures	Look at and appreciate different artists such as Dan Fenelon, Banksy, Diego Rivera, Caravaggio, Pablo Picasso and Leonardo da Vinci
PSHE	Celebrating differences and dreams and goals.	Encourage our children to talk about their dreams and goals as well as celebrating their achievements.
Music	You've got a friend.	Listen to and appreciate music. Think about the different instruments used as well as the Tempo and genre of the music.
PE	Gymnastics, netball, handball and tennis.	Think and talk about how team work is important in different games.
Computing	Spreadsheets.	When creating a shopping list, you could put it onto excel or Google sheets and use formula ro add up the cost!
Latin	Secondus Latin	Research the Roman Army and what a role as a Legionary would entailed.
