Year 4 Spring Term Curriculum		How you can support learning at home
Reading	The Abominables by Eva Ibbotson	Listen to reading and pose questions to improve understanding. Why did the character....? When...? Where...? What if...?
Writing	Using ! ? “ ” ‘ ’ within sentences	Practise writing sentences, using punctuation accurately.
Maths	Multiplication and Division, Measure, Fractions and Decimals	TT rockstars to support with multiplication, alongside exploring My Maths and BBC Bitesize for extra maths challenges.
Science (Spr1/2)	Human Nutrition, Sound	Talk about keeping teeth healthy and parts of the ear.
R.E	Galilee to Jerusalem.	Discuss with your child that Catholics pray the Creed to show their faith, are forgiven in Reconciliation, and receive God's strength in the Anointing of the Sick.
Geography (Spr.1)	Rivers and the Water Cycle	Talk about the water cycle and why it is vital for clean water.
History (Spr. 2)	Roman Britain	Research Julius Caesar and his historical significance.
Art (Spr.1)	Light and Dark	Visit a the Lightbox in Woking and look for examples.
DT (Spr. 2)	Slingshot Cars	Look at toys at home and discuss how they move.
PSHE (Spr1/2)	What is puberty?	Talking about the natural changes that happen as you become older.
Music	Highlighting importance of stage presence, Introducing sheet music, exploring a wider breadth of musical terms, Introduction to emotion into the voice!	Have fun exploring different musical performance shows online and discuss the importance of stage presence and listen out for emotion in the voice, when performers sing.
PE (Spr1/2)	Gymnastics, Hockey, Tennis, Handball	Play a small game of the ones taught with friends.
Computing (Spr. 1)	Repetition in Shapes, Data-logging	Discussions about staying safe on the internet.
Latin (Spr. 2)	Clean and Healthy, A soldiers Life	Explore Latin word games online at Wordwall.net
