

How you can support learning at home

Reading	Boy at the back of the class.	Listen to your child read and ask comprehension questions to check their understanding.
Writing	Writing from fiction and non-fiction stimulus. Suffragettes.	Discuss different vocabulary and synonyms for words to expand your child's vocabulary.
maths	SATs Revision and problem solving.	Use SATS - Arithmetic (mathsbot.com) to help with arithmetic papers. Make sure your children know their timetables.
Science	Evolution and inheritance Transition lessons.	Think about how different animals have adapted to their environments to survive.
R.E	To the Ends of the Earth.	Think about the common good for our world.
Geography & History	Geography- Our world in the future History—The impact of war.	Think about how we should preserve our local area. Visit Brookwood cemetery or the cenotaph.
Art & D&T	Art— 3D sculptures D&T Digital world—Navigating the world.	When out and about, look at different statues and think about what they mean and their purpose. Also, for D&T, look out for different uses of technology in our everyday lives.
PSHE	Healthy me and preparing for transition to secondary school.	Discuss their transition to secondary school with them. It is important they are aware of how they will be getting to school and anything that might change to their routine.
Music	Music and me	When listening to music, discuss what you like about it and think about what instruments are used.
PE	Cricket, athletics and Sports day Practice	Play a small game of the ones taught with friends.
Computing	Crumble Kit	Think about how electronics work!
