Admissions reminder for Reception 2021

The admissions team at Surrey have asked us to distribute the following message to parents:

*In an effort to reduce the number of late applications received, we would be very grateful if you could remind parents with children in your school, including parents with pre-school siblings, that the national closing date for Reception applications for September 2021 entry is **15 January 2021**.*

Any opportunity that you may have to mention this to parents - such as an end of term newsletter, an email to parents etc - would be much appreciated, in the hope that parents will complete an application over the Christmas holidays if they have not already.

We strongly encourage online applications via <https://www.eadmissions.org.uk/eAdmissions/app>. If parents are unable to apply online, they will need to request a paper application form via the Surrey Schools & Childcare Service (0300 200 1004, Mon-Fri 9am-5pm). The completed paper application form must be received by Admissions (to our Quadrant Court address) by 15 January, so parents must allow time for the post to reach us. If parents need to apply on paper, we recommend that they send applications by recorded post.

Full information is available on Surrey's website at www.surreycc.gov.uk/primaryadmissions. The Surrey Schools & Childcare Service can also provide impartial help in completing an application.

Applications received after the closing date without good reason will be treated as late and will not be considered until all on time applications have been processed. This may jeopardise the chance of a parent being offered one of their preferred schools for their child.

Covid reporting procedures over the Christmas holiday

As a trust we have decided to centralise our track and trace efforts over the Christmas period and so I'm asking that should the worst happen and your child tests positive between 18th December and Christmas day please contact emergency@xavier.cet.org.uk and we will put in place appropriate track and trace procedures. Please note, that this is a different email address to our usual Covid notification one. After Christmas Eve, you don't need to notify us of Covid cases on the address above as the regular government track and trace procedures take over.

At the beginning of the new term, please do not send your children to school if you have been told to self-isolate or any member of your household becomes symptomatic. If this applies to you, please email info@sthugh-of-lincoln.surrey.sch.uk to report your child's absence as usual. We will begin to monitor our Covid@sthugh-of-lincoln.surrey.sch.uk account again from 6th January.
