It has been a very exciting week as the contractors have started work in our creation garden.

Year 6 have been particularly excited to see their plans and designs starting to take shape whilst they are working towards their faith in action awards.





## Drama and Science in Year 2

In Year 2 we have been reading the story of the Magic Finger by Roald Dahl in English. The children had great fun acting out parts of the story, adding dialogue and freeze framing.

In Science Year 2 have been naming and classifying a variety of food that humans eat by plant or animal origins. They tried to remember the foods they had eaten in the last two days and then attempted to sort them into categories. They also had to look very closely at food packaging and find out the ingredients and where they originated.



## Racing cars and French Boules in Year 3

Year 3 are enjoying their new science topic 'Magnets and Forces'. They created catapults to race toy cars and observed how changing the amount of force affects how toy cars move on flat surfaces. They also played French boules on the playground and field to compare how balls travel on different surfaces. Both investigations allowed the children to practice the skills of making a prediction and drawing a conclusion from their findings.





## Year 4 Geography

In Geography we have been exploring what happens when the Earth shakes. We learnt what earthquakes are and how they are caused. We used the globes and atlases to locate recent earthquakes. Next week we are going to be learning about volcanoes around the world.



Year 4 also enjoyed a lovely interactive drama workshop to support their Geography topic Volcanoes and Earthquakes. They embarked on a trek visiting different places around the world that have experienced natural disasters and role played the different stages of volcano.





## Year 5 - Milestones Museum

Year 5 spent Wednesday at the Milestones Local History Museum in Basingstoke. Learning about changes brought about by the Industrial Revolution, the children had an opportunity to explore the extensive collection of local history exhibits. Other experiences included a session with Mrs Tasker, a Victorian factory owner, learning about how industrialisation changed the lives of ordinary people; and a typical 1899 lesson with a very strict school teacher. Year 5 had a wonderful time bringing their history learning to life.
