A few reminders

Equipment Year 1 – Year 6

Please can your check your child's pencil case and ensure that they have all the vital resources they need. Sometimes things run out so we would really appreciate it, if you could check their stock of equipment from time to time and replenish as needed.

Pencil cases should be clear and unfussy. Unfortunately, some of the pencil cases that are currently being brought into school do not fit into the children's trays which is making it difficult for them to manage. Please can you supply your child with a simple, clear pencil case filled with: A glue stick, Blue ink handwriting pen x 2, pencil x 2, sharpener, whiteboard pen, ruler, rubber and a small selection of coloured pencils.



School Uniform

As we enter the summer term, children may wear the summer uniform. Please check the school website for details.

Earrings may not be worn for health and safety reasons and long/shoulder length hair needs to be tied back. Please ensure that hair accessories are simple, soft and in school colours. Large bows and hard plastic attachments are not permitted.

Messenger bags and school bags are the only bags allowed in school as we do not have space to store rucksacs or large bags.

Please ensure that water bottles contain only water.
