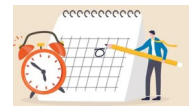

Year 5 Spring Term Curriculum		How you can support learning at home
Reading	Reading Street Child and My friend Walter.	Make sure your child is reading a variety of fiction and non-fiction books and changing their books regularly in the school library.
Writing	Children will be completing different tasks such as writing newspapers, poems, diary entries etc.	Focus on practicing handwriting and spelling, punctuation and grammar. Make sure you complete SPAG.com homework.
maths	Graphs & Tables, Are & Perimeter, Multiplication & Division 2.	Complete MyMaths homework as well as practicing timetables for example on TTRS.
Science	Types of change and separating mixtures	Using different equipment to help separate solids and liquids at home.
R.E	Mission & Sacrifice	Encourage your child to pray and attend masses.
Geography & History	Europe: A study of the Alpine Region The Vikings	Encourage your children to find out additional facts about the Vikings. Take out a book from the library about the mountains in Europe.
Art & D&T	Making a pop up book Drawing: I need space	Look at the different pop up books and how they have created the pop ups in them.
PSHE	Dreams and goals	Encourage our children to talk about their dreams and goals as well as celebrating their achievements.
Music	Clarinet lessons	Listen to and appreciate music. Think about the different instruments used as well as the Tempo and genre of the music.
PE	Gymnastics, Netball, Tennis and Handball	Think and talk about how team work is important in different games.
Computing	Databases	Create a graph or chart themselves using their own data.
Latin	Topic of clean and healthy and a soldier's life.	Look at the Roman Baths in Bath on the internet or if you're looking for a day trip, visit the Roman baths!
