Reading	Read Write Inc.	Read the RWI books and bring them to school everyday. Read your 'book for pleasure' school library book. Continue to watch the RWI links in the newsletter. Visit your local library.

Maths	Addition & subtraction to 20 Numbers to 50 Length & Height Weight and Volume	Practise counting in 2s,5s and 10s. Use the game 'hit the button' to practise numbers bonds to 10 and 20. Measure items within your home (cm or m). If you bake at home encourage your child to weigh out the ingredients.
Science	Identifying Materials Types of Animals	Try toy sorting, think about the properties of the different materials they are made from. This website is fantastic for further ideas: https://www.science-sparks.com/introducing-materials/
R.E	Galilee to Jerusalem	Read Bible Stories and learn our school prayers. These can be found on the school website. On YouTube there is a channel called 'Saddleback Kids' if your child would prefer to watch the bible stories.
Geography	People and their communities	Encourage your child to create their own maps of places they have visited. You could have a family world map of the countries you have visited. You might



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History	The Greatest Explorers	Research Captain James Cook. To be able to define the word 'explorer'.
D&T	Textiles– Puppets	Explore how different items of clothing have been joined together. Continue to learn how to do a simple stitch.
PSHE	Dreams and Goals Healthy Me	Create a vision board with your child. Cut out pictures of hopes and dreams and create a poster. Put the vision board somewhere you can see it. Discuss the importance of eating healthy, sleeping, exercising, looking after our bodies and drinking water. You might want to create a family chart to see who drinks the most water.
Music	Learning and Appraising Music	When listening to music at think about: Pulse – the regular heartbeat of the music; its steady beat. Rhythm – long and short sounds or patterns that happen over the pulse. Pitch – high and low sounds. Tempo – the speed of the music; fast or slow or in-between. Dynamics – how loud or quiet the music is.
PE	Ball Skills and Team Building Net & Wall and Striking & Fielding	Attend the Woking Junior Park Run at 9am every Sunday morning. Can you scoot to school? Can you ride to school? Can you walk to school? Head to your local park and let the children show you their ball skills.
Computing	Moving a robot	Download the Educational app 'Bee-Bot' and the children can practise their coding skills. Continue to discuss staying safe on the internet.
Art	Sculpture and 3D: Paper play 	To create their own paper play pictures. Here are 7 simple craft ideas: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=uc1oMuLOZ5c
