Science Fair – Andrew Davey

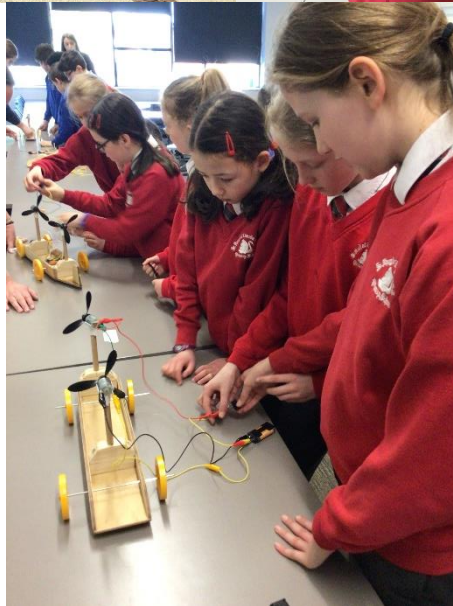
