








# Journeys - Food

## Year 2 - Spring

 farm	Where animals and crops are raised and grown
 agriculture	Another word for farming
 pasture	Land where animals are put to graze e.g. the sheep eat the grass.
 arable	Land which is used to grow crops
 crops	Plants which are grown by farmer e.g. vegetables, fruit and grain
 grain	Small, dry, hard seeds that can be harvested for animals and humans to eat e.g. wheat, oats, barley
 harvest	Gathering a crop when it is ripe from the field.

### Stages of food production

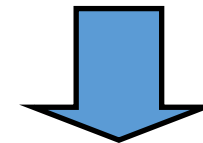
Farmers grow grain, fruit or vegetables. They rear animals.

Washed, cut, changed, cooked or mixed together in a factory.

Packed into a box or bag and delivered.

Bought in shops and markets or delivered.
