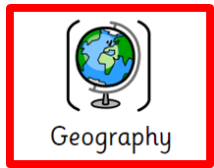











Changes in our local environment

 <p>continent</p>	<p>Land mass defined by physical, human, or cultural features: Europe, Africa, Antarctica, Asia, Oceania, North America or South America</p>
 <p>country</p>	<p>A political areas defined by physical, human or cultural features.</p>
 <p>region</p>	<p>An area or part of a country which has a certain characteristic e.g. southeast England</p>
 <p>county</p>	<p>Usually made up of cities, towns, or rural populations. They have a local government. E.g. Surrey, Hampshire</p>
 <p>borough</p>	<p>A town or a division of a large town e.g. Woking, Guildford</p>
<p>regeneration</p>	<p>Improving an existing area to bring about economic and social change. Land is often used for a new purpose e.g. the use of land in the East of London for the 2012 Olympics.</p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around;">   </div>
