These anchor the plant into the ground and absorb water and nutrients from the soil.

This holds the plant up and carries water and nutrients from the soil to the leaves and flowers. A trunk is the stem of a tree.

These make seeds to grow into new plants.




petal The brightly coloured part of the flower that attracts insects, to pollinate the plant.
