


Plants

Year 1 - Summer

<p>roots</p>	<p>These anchor the plant into the ground and absorb water and nutrients from the soil.</p>
<p>stem</p>	<p>This holds the plant up and carries water and nutrients from the soil to the leaves and flowers. A trunk is the stem of a tree.</p>
<p>leaves</p>	<p>These make food for the plant using sunlight and carbon dioxide from the air.</p>
<p>flower</p>	<p>These make seeds to grow into new plants.</p>
<p>petal</p>	<p>The brightly coloured part of the flower that attracts insects, to pollinate the plant.</p>
<p>seed</p>	<p>The small part of a flowering plant that grows into a new plant.</p>



Evergreen Trees	Deciduous Trees
<p>Keep their green leaves all year round.</p> <p>E.g. Fir Tree</p>	<p>Lose their leaves each year during Autumn.</p> <p>E.g. Oak Tree</p>
