

# Habitats






## Year 2 - Summer

 habitat	A habitat is the natural place where something stays alive.. It provides living things with everything that they need to survive such as food, shelter and water.
 survive	This means to stay alive.
 depend	Many living things depend on each other. This means that they need each other for different things.
 micro-habitat	A microhabitat is a very small habitat like under leaves, under a log or on a tree bark.
Carnivore Herbivore Omnivore	Carnivore: Meat eater. Herbivore: Plant eater. Omnivore: Eats meat and plants.
