 Holy Spirit	One of the three parts to God - God the Spirit.
 Ascension	When Jesus' physical body rose up to Heaven.
 Pentecost	The day when the Holy Spirit, represented as fire, filled the Apostles.
Saul	A follower of Jesus, whose name changed to Paul.
 prayer	A way to communicate to God.
Fruits of the Spirit	Ways that St Paul describes the Holy Spirit. Love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithful, gentleness and self-control.

 **Hear:**


- Jesus appears to the apostles and the Ascension (Lk 24:36-53)
- Pentecost and Peter talks to the crowd. (Acts 2:1-9.12-13)
- Conversion of Saul (Acts 9:1-19)
- Fruits of the Holy Spirit (Gal 5:22-23)

 **Believe:**

- God is love. Love is God's first gift poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit.
- The fruits of the Spirit are the visible signs that a person is led by the Holy Spirit.
- The fruits of the Spirit are love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithful, gentleness and self-control.

 **Live:**

- That there are different symbols of the Holy Spirit in art: wind, fire, and dove.
- The example of a saint who showed examples of peacebuilding in their lives, i.e St Francis of Assisi.

 **Celebrate:**

- In all prayers, Christians welcome the Holy Spirit and open their hearts to God.
- Christians pray to the Holy Spirit for help ("Come Holy Spirit").
