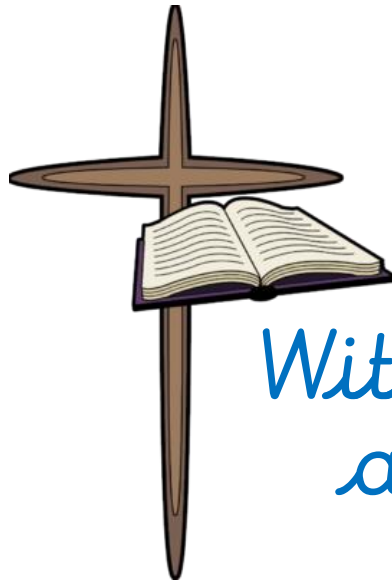

Butser Farm Shopping List
