Throughout 2019-20 we provided mathematics intervention groups throughout the year, run by teachers before the start of the normal school day. Children with Pupil Premium entitlement were targeted, and this helped to achieve the progress and attainment that was achieved at the end of Key Stage 2. Additionally intervention sessions have been run by teaching assistants during the school day, targeting pupils with Pupil Premium eligibility on a 1:1 basis or within a small group. It is by being able to provide additional adult support within and outside of the classroom that the large majority of Pupil Premium funding was spent. All Pupil Premium grant was used to enable additional adult contact with eligible pupils.

In addition to providing Maths and English support (through precision teaching and through general in-class support with learning), support has been tailored to the needs of the individual child, e.g. through providing emotional support (through Rainbows) and support for communication skills (Gingerbread).

Excellent CPD in Phonics, Guided Reading and Whole Class English lessons for all teachers and LSAs has been funded by the Pupil Premium grant this year, which has led to improved outcomes for all children as well as those eligible pupils.

We have been able to provide emotional literacy support through two trained members of staff, and this has benefitted pupils with Pupil Premium entitlement.

Throughout school closure, due to Covid-19, we delivered high quality lessons through Microsoft Teams. All eligible children were provided with necessary materials to enable them to access this.
