



St Hugh Of Lincoln Pupil Premium Planned Spend 2020-2021

Background

The Pupil Premium is a grant allocated to children from low-income families who are currently known to be eligible for Free School Meals (FSM) and children who have been looked after continuously for more than six months. This also includes pupils eligible for FSM at any point in the last six years (known as the Ever 6 FSM measure). This year, 8 children are eligible for the Pupil Premium funding grant.

Pupil Premium Planned Allocation 2020-2021

During this academic year, we anticipate using the grant of £15,105 as follows:

Activity Selected	Pupils Targeted	Cost	Intended Impact
Small group precision teaching	Year R	£500	To support children in making expected progress.
Drawing and Talking Therapy	Year 6	£250	To support the emotional literacy of children facing challenges.
ELSA support sessions	Years 3, 5 and 6	£750	To support the emotional literacy of children and to support children with mental health difficulties.
Additional 1:1 support for children on FSM to support learning	Year 3 and Year 5	£4,000	To give intensive support to children so that expected progress.
Resources for curriculum interventions	Years R, 1, 2, 3, 5 and 6	£5000	To support children in all areas of the curriculum.
Specialists assessments by SENCO	Years R, 1, 3, 5 and 6	£1,155	To assess children and provide a baseline from which progress can be measured.
Support for school visits, trips & extra-curricular activities	Year 6	£400	To enrich the curriculum for children and to provide access to wider experiences.
Staff Phonics training Staff Drawing Therapy Training	Years R, 1, 2, 3, 5 and 6	£800	To ensure that curriculum interventions are accurately delivered to achieve the desired results.
Focused Pastoral Support	Years R, 1, 2, 3, 5 and 6	£2000	To ensure that pupils (and their families) are well supported emotionally and socially and have access to the right services at the right time.
Cool Milk	Years 1 and 2	£150	To provide children with milk.
